PRE-REGISTER NOW FOR FARM-i-GEDDON!!! Official Registration Opens Sept. 28

This year's DroneFest at SUNY Poly is CANCELLED - \otimes -BUT - we're still kicking-off the FARM-i-GEDDON season with an online meeting!

FREE PRE-REGISTRATION is already available for teams that wish to get an early start on the 2020 FARM-i-GEDDON Team Drone Challenge. Pre-registration allows us to pre-qualify teams, assist new coaches & give access to our new format - PART I of our new 2 PART Challenge Manual. We're holding an online informational kick-off for interested team coaches and students at 7:00pm on September 28th.

This year's competition format features up to **12 teams** from Middle/High School + **NEW FOR 2020** - up to 12 university level teams! We're expanding our reach by giving students opportunities to interact with peers already in higher education STEM programs!

Registration opens at 5:00pm on September 28th on our website. School POs or checks via PayPal will be accepted. For either level, Registration is only \$100 per team through November 30, 2019 or when each division fills. If needed, Late Registration is \$175 from December 1, 2019 to January 29, 2019 or when each division fills. Registered teams receive access to Team Resources Files in addition to PART II of the Challenge Manual. Teams can practice without heavy investment, typically



under **\$1,000**, including registration & equipment. There is no need to purchase the field or elements --- the entire program was created with cost in mind. Measurements and weights of items are provided to registered teams. Monthly Tech Meet dates are set & can be attended by full or partial teams, coaches, parents & those new to drone tech looking to get started. Meets include indoor drone races for those with Whoop class drones. (schedule on next page)
